For chapters of edited books, put each author's last name, then a comma, then the first initial of the first name, then any additional initials. A period should follow each initial. Separate the last author from the second-to-last author with a comma and ampersand (&). Separate any additional authors by commas.

APA REFERENCE STYLE: Chapters in Edited Books

To create a reference for a chapter in an edited book, follow the example for a chapter in an edited book without a DOI. At the end of the reference, after the publisher, add the DOI using the current DOI URL format. The current standard for the DOI begins with "https://doi.org/". Do not add a period after the DOI.

For a chapter or article in an edited print book, include the word 'In' before the name of the editor/s as shown in the reference list example. Note that the editor's initials are placed before the surname. Edited Books: No Chapter Authors

If there are different authors for each chapter, you need to reference EACH chapter you use. If you

use multiple chapters from a book with different authors for each chapter, you still need to reference EACH chapter you use. (This is because you need to acknowledge who wrote the work you are using, not the person who edited/compiled the book).

The formats for references to chapters in edited books are: Author, A. A., & Author, B. B. (year). Title of the chapter or entry. In A. Editor, B. Editor, & C. C. Editor (Eds.), Title of the book (pp. xxx-xxx).

Here is the basic format for a reference list entry of a chapter in a book in APA style 6th edition: Author (s) of the chapter. (Year of publication).

In this case, try to get as specific as possible by mentioning chapter, section, and paragraph numbers. One of the author's main points is that "people don't rise from nothing" (Gladwell, 2008, Chapter 1, Section 2, para. 5). Formatting your References Once you type your references on the reference page, you will need to put in a hanging indent and double-space the entire reference list. In Microsoft Word, highlight the references from A to Z, then find the paragraph function in the Word ribbon. Select Hanging under Indentation and Double under spacing.
