In general, poverty in Ghana is reduced more by international than internal remittances. Consequently, remittances have a positive effect on poverty in Zambia. The 5% increase of remittances resulted into a 7% reduction of poverty. We therefore encourage the Government to produce and implement policies that would attract increased flow of remittances as one of the measures to reduce poverty.
