Parliament is considering the report of the Finance Committee on the Revenue Administration (Amendment) Bill, 2020. The Bill seeks to amend the Revenue Administration Act, 2016 (Act 915) to establish an Independent Tax Appeals Board (ITAB) to hear and determine appeals against tax decisions made by the Commissioner-General, allowing for the payment of a shortfall in tax liability.

The GRA usually gives notice of its intention to perform a tax audit and, after performance, prepares a report on its findings, which is then shared with the taxpayer. Statute of limitations The Revenue Administration Act, 2016 (Act 915) (RAA) requires all taxable persons to maintain records of all receipts and payments, revenue and expenditure, and all assets and liabilities for a period of not less than six years.

As is the nature of taxes in all countries, Ghana's tax system plays fundamental role of raising government's revenue, redistribution of wealth and income, re-pricing of goods and services, as well as affording citizens the power of representation - a setting that has the potential of ensuring good state - society relations through good governance and accountability.

BASELINE STUDY OF GHANA'S TAX SYSTEM

The tax holidays are designed to suit different types of farming activities e.g. cash crops, tree crops, fish farming, and crop, fish and livestock processing. Farmers and companies cultivating tree crops such as coffee, oil palm, sheanut, rubber and coconut are entitled to a tax ten (10) year tax holiday from date of first harvest of their crops.

In Ghana, income tax is levied each year on the income of both resident and non- resident persons. Resident persons are taxed on their worldwide income, while non-resident persons are taxed on income which has a source in Ghana. Generally, income has a source in Ghana if it accrues in or is derived from Ghana.
