Seven Elements of the Social Work Relationship

Based on a conviction that the casework function excludes assigning guilt or innocence, or degree of client responsibility for causation of the problems or needs, but does include making evaluative judgements about the attitudes, standards, or action of the client, which involves both thought and feeling elements, is transmitted to the client.

The worker's response is not only verbal; it is also nonverbal. The worker becomes "involved" emotionally by sensing and responding to feelings.
